The Poppenspe(e)lmuseum's Puppet and Puppetry Information Centre provides insight into the wide variety of forms that international folk and mainstream puppet theatre can take.

- In principle, the book, multimedia and audio libraries, and the video-theque are open by appointment.
- About nine thousand titles of books in Dutch and other languages can be consulted via our bilingual puppetry website. - Works, videotapes and DVDs cannot be loaned out.
- Copying and scanning equipment is available to copy/scan interesting articles and pictures that can then be studied elsewhere. Black-and-white and colour copies and prints are available. We can also make scans and provide digital files.
- The books can be found via the *computer* and the *shelf mark stickers* on the spines of book covers. Visitors are invited to help themselves to the books and documents on the shelves and to replace them. Please insert a *marking pistol* to mark the empty space on the shelf when removing an item for perusal.
- All costs will be charged in advance. The goods ordered will be dispatched to the stated address (by regular mail or by e-mail) no later than two weeks after receipt of the amount payable.
